Palliative Care Tasmania 'PalliCare Fundamentals' certificate program aims to provide participants with understanding of the key foundation aspects of palliative care.

The program would benefit those entering any aged care or palliative care practice, update skills for practitioners at all levels and consolidate prior learning as a professional development activity.

Suitable for:

Health care professionals, Aged Care staff, Carers, Volunteers, HACC or CHSP providers or those interested in learning more about palliative care.

Delivery:

15 hours of facilitator led education that aligns with palliative care qualifications nationally. 6 core units | 2.5-hour sessions | 1 session per month over 6 months | Offered twice per year. Participants can attend individual sessions but can only receive the 'PalliCare Fundamentals' certificate if all 6 sessions are completed.

Investment:

PCT Member: \$150.00 for the course or \$30.00 per individual unit.

Non-Member: \$250.00 for the course or \$50.00 per unit.
